This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of year 5 students in the Upper two bands, Reading from 19% to 33%
- Increase the percentage of year 3 students in the Upper two bands, Reading from 28% to 38%

Our initiatives include

- Regular feedback loops.
- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: Reading
- Develop teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle
- Provide intensive support for students demonstrating high levels of achievement
- Increasing specialist time across the school to better support our staff and students

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ extra Speech Language Pathologist time. (\$24000)
- Engage a pre prep program commencing term one. (\$25000)
- Supply teacher aide hours for the pre prep program. (\$10000)
- Employ a positive behaviour support person. (\$80000)
- Increase Head of Curriculum time to enable a change of role which will incorporate curriculum and warm ups. (\$50000)
- Employ a full time teacher aide for the Resource Centre. (\$43000)
- Purchase TRS to release staff so as explicit pedagogical feedback can be given to all teaching staff. (\$22000)
